Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that the next date of hearing before the trial Court for recording the evidence of prosecution witnesses is 15.01.2018 when four prosecution witnesses have been summoned. Out of the total 26 prosecution witnesses, 10 witnesses have already been examined.

Since the petitioner is in custody for more than two years and 9 months, it would be in the interest of justice that the trial be expedited and the trial Court should grant short dates for completing the trial at an early date.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn at this stage.
