By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.222 dated 28.12.2017 registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana, Punjab under Sections 336, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 1.11.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has been received to the effect that the statements of the petitioner/accused Baljinder Singh as well as of complainant Nishant Naggar have been recorded to the

effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.222 dated 28.12.2017 registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana, Punjab under Sections 336, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
