The instant petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case registered or likely to be registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on the basis of complaint dated 13.09.2018 moved by the complainant Ginni Duggal against the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer that that respondent should be directed to comply with the provisions of Section 160 of Code of Criminal Procedure and to give an advance notice of at least 7 days, in case the petitioners are required to be called in connection with the complaint filed by complainant Ginni Duggal.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the limited prayer made, the instant petition stands disposed of with a

direction to the respondent-State that in the event of arrest of the petitioners in connection with the complaint filed by complainant Ginni Duggal, a seven days notice well in advance and in writing shall be served upon the petitioners to enable them to avail their legal remedies in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
