Petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.24 dated 26.01.2014 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh, on the basis of compromise dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-2).

2. Parties have entered into a compromise. This Court by order dated 20.11.2017 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 21.12.2017.

3. In view of the law laid down in Narinder Singh v. State of Punjab; 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.24 dated 26.01.2014 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh, alongwith all consequential proceeding arising out of this FIR are hereby quashed.

4. Petitioners are liable to pay litigation cost of Rs.10000/- (Rs.2000/- by each of the petitioner) to the Home Department of State of Haryana within a period of 2 months from today.
