The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.494 dated 3.9.2018, registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, Gurugram, under Section 174-A IPC.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated 10.10.2018, the petitioners have joined investigation and are cooperating therewith.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2, however, submits that keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, the petitioners do not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view nature of the offence, custodial interrogation of the accused person is not necessary. Thus, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 10.10.2018, is

made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under
Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by them.
