The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, “Cr.P.C.”) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.183 dated 18.7.2011 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) and 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner submits that the the petitioner has already been granted bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge (ad hoc), Fast Track Court, Gurdaspur vide order dated 7.1.2015 but subsequently he jumped the bail and could not be arrested. Now, the petitioner is in custody since 27.2.2017.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Partap Singh son of Sarabjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
