Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5. The respondent No.4 is stated to be a police personnel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar City. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the said representation qua the protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, but considering the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner viz. a viz. the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner only, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to consider the aforesaid representation dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner to the extent of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner only and to act in accordance with law.
