The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.116 dated 06.04.2015, registered under Sections 365, 395, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bilaspur, Gurgaon.

Vide order dated 16.08.2017, petitioner was directed to join the investigation on 17.08.2017. However the petitioner could not join the investigation and filed Crl. Misc. No.26022 of 2017 for extension of time for joining the investigation as he was away to Rajasthan.

Though, no specific order has been passed in the said

application, however according to learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lovekesh Kumar, petitioner has joined the investigation on 30.10.2017 and is no more required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 16.08.2017 is made absolute.
