The merits of the case for or against the petitioner apart, which according to the learned counsel for the petitioner has a version and cross-version thereto, as has been recorded in detail by the learned trial Court in paragraphs 8 to 15 of the order dated 22.01.2018 rejecting the petitioners' petition for anticipatory bail filed before that Court, the fact remains that the petitioner and his co-accused did not appear before the trial Court despite repeated summons and warrants issued, despite even one of the warrants having been directed to be effected/executed through the Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, the petitioner being an SHO in District Jhajjar.

Hence, the petitioner despite belonging to a uniformed force, very obviously deliberately avoided summons and warrants to be served upon him and executed, even being shielded by his superiors, as it is unbelievable that he could not be found even by the Superintendent of Police to whom he reports, and therefore the warrants issued were not

executed.

Consequently, I find absolutely no reason to entertain this petition, which is accordingly dismissed.
