Petitioner Jasbir Singh Khullar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.301 dated 22.09.2018, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been got registered by complainant-Sanjay Kumar with the allegations that he went to the shop of the petitioner and his sons, where co-accused Kaka son of the present petitioner was sitting and the complainant asked him for transferring ₹10 lacs from his account to his wife's account. Then co-

accused Kaka rang up to co-accused Anup Khullar, who transferred the said

amount to some other account not to his wife's account. When, he did not receive any message on his wife's phone, thereafter, he went to the shop again, where the present petitioner, who is the father of co-accused was sitting and he stated that there could be some fault, the message would be received after some time.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the present petitioner had also connived with their sons.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
