Petitioners-Jagveer Singh, Rajvir Singh, Sandeep Singh alias Bhullar and Kaju Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 30.05.2018, registered at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Section 365 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar submit that parties have effected the compromise.

Otherwise also, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 11.10.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
