The present petition has been filed for quashing of DDR No. 17 dated 26.02.2015 registered under Section 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 in case FIR No. 24 dated 26.02.2015 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 23.10.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 20.11.2017, report dated 18.12.2017 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the DDR No. 17 dated 26.02.2015 registered under Section 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 in case FIR No. 24 dated 26.02.2015 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Daresi,

District Ludhiana, and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
