Petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.62 dated 06.10.2017 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. The present FIR is out-come of sudden quarrel and with the intervention of the respectable parties arrived at compromise.

3. Parties have entered into a compromise vide Annexure P-2. This Court by order dated 12.03.2018 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridkot and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 10.04.2018 from which it is evident that compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion.

4. In view of the law laid down in **Narinder Singh** v. **State of Punjab**; 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing

the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.62 dated 06.10.2017 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot alongwith all consequential proceeding arising out of this FIR are hereby quashed subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.3000/- by each of the petitioner. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury, State of Punjab, within a period of 2 months from today.
