This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.115 dated 19.08.2015 registered under Sections 307, 472/34 IPC, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, he was not involved. No offence under Section 307 IPC is made out. The petitioner has undergone custody of one year and two months. Co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Vikram Kumar @ Bunty has been released on regular bail vide order dated 19.02.2018 passed in ***CRM-M No.42981 of 2017.***

Learned State counsel has not disputed the custody period as well as release of co-accused on regular bail but he has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground of seriousness of offence.

By considering the role of the petitioner at par with co-accused,

who has been released on regular bail; his custody; all witnesses are the official witnesses and out of total 34 witnesses, three witnesses have been examined, the present petition is allowed and petitioner, namely, Satnam Singh @ Satta is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
