The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.77 dated 02.07.2015, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that the matter has been resolved amicably between the parties and in fact, a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has already been preferred, in which statement of the parties under the first motion has been recorded. Under the said proceedings, complainant-respondent No.2 has also stated that she will

withdraw all the pending cases filed by her against her husband and his family members and if required, she will make a statement for quashing of the proceedings under the aforesaid FIR.

In view of the fact that the matter stands compromised and the petitioner herein has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 16.12.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
