Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 11.06.2017, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala, under Sections 304, 323, 120-B, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner after lifting his father had thrown him against the wall and struck against the ground also. Perusal of record shows that the

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doctor has not given any cause of death in this case and stated that it cannot be ascertained as there was no evidence of any trauma or poison.

The private witnesses have already been examined. The petitioner has been in custody since 14.09.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
