On the last date of hearing learned counsel for the petitioners had submitted that out of 15 prosecution witnesses two have been examined; however, learned State counsel on instructions submits that 8 out of 15 prosecution witnesses have been examined, with the remaining witnesses summoned for 06.06.2018.

That being so, with the petitioners having approached this court for quashing of the FIR at this stage, the petition cannot be entertained and is consequently dismissed.

However, dismissal of the petition would not be construed as any observation of this Court on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioners, which would be gone into by the trial Court wholly on the basis of evidence led before it.
