By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 so as to protect his life and liberty and also of other members of his family as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10.

Another prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.4 to 6 so as to give atleast one week's advance notice in case, the petitioner is required in connection with any inquiry or investigation.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had purchased land situated in Village Haibowal Kalan on 14.12.2015 from Dharminder Singh Deol and that mutation was effected pursuant to the said sale-deed. It has been submitted that the private respondents on the basis of forged documents executed a sale-deed in respect of this very land, regarding which the petitioner lodged an FIR, which was investigated and trial is pending. The learned counsel has further submitted that respondents No.7 to 10, on the basis of forged recored have been attempting to

dispossess the petitioner and although he had made representation to the police but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 26.9.2018, moved by petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. Further in case it is found that there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner or to other members of his family, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioner or to other members of his family. It is further directed that in case the petitioner is required to be associated in connection with any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from him, then an advance notice in terms of Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to him. A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-6) dated 26.9.2018 be sent to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
