Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 10.09.2018 under Sections 306 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Mahilpur HSP, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 11.10.2018, the following order was passed:-

“..... Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, deceased Jatinder Singh was having illicit relations with wife of the petitioner namely Anita Rani. The petitioner and co-accused Palwinder Singh have snubbed said Jatinder Singh and on that account, he consumed poison on 09.09.2018 and later on died. It is further submitted that no suicide note was recovered and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner that he has acted in a manner, which has abetted the deceased to commit suicide.

Notice of motion for 03.12.2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, order dated 11.10.2018 is made absolute.
