The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.262 dated 29.07.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 489-C IPC.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner induced the complainant to part with a sum of Rs.1 lac for doubling the same. The complainant arranged a sum of Rs.1 lac by selling his shop. The money was handed over to a co-accused, who returned Rs.10,000/- in counter-feit currency and promised to return the balance amount after some time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused, who received the money has been granted regular bail. No recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and the petitioner is willing to join investigation. Thus, anticipatory bail be granted to him.

The complainant has made specific allegations against the petitioner. He has specifically named the petitioner as the person, who informed him about the scheme of doubling the money. It was at the instance of the petitioner that the complainant sold his business and paid a

sum of Rs.1 lac to the co-accused through the petitioner. Under the circumstances, the petitioner does not deserve any discretionary relief.

The petition is accordingly, dismissed.
