Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition granting him liberty to approach the Court of Sessions to challenge the summoning order dated 22.01.2015. He has further requested that since petitioners No.1 and 2, Ram Parkash and Krishana Devi, father-in-law and mother-in-law of the complainant are of old age, not keeping good health and Balwinder Kaur wife of Sukhdev Singh is having two minor children whom she is to look after. Besides Sukhdev Singh has to travel from Garhshankar to Mansa Court for attending the proceedings and thereby some orders granting exemption of personal appearance be passed.

Heard.

Allowed.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that after Ram Parkash, Krishana Devi, Balwinder Singh as well as Sukhdev Singh put in appearance in the trial Court and move application(s) for

exempting their personal appearance, the trial Court would exempt personal appearance of these petitioners subject to the condition that they would be represented by their counsel, their identity shall not be disputed, and no adjournment shall be sought for the reason of their identification. The trial Court may direct them to appear in the Court, if their appearance is found to be necessary.
