Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.399 dated 31.10.2017, registered under Sections 328, 420, 467, 471, 120-B, 34 IPC (Sections 420, 467, 471, 120-B IPC added lateron) at Police Station Civil Lines, Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for complainant has submitted that compromise has been partially effected between the parties and out of Rs.50,000/-, Rs.16,000/- has been paid and remaining amount is due.

However, learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to

the petitioners in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 19.12.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
