The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.24 dated 3.8.2018, registered at Police Station Mohkampura, District Amritsar, under Sections 22/ 25/ 29 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to grant of interim bail as the FSL report has not been received till date.

Custody certificate dated 14.11.2018, by way of an affidavit of Sh. R.K. Arora, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record. According to said certificate, the petitioner has been undergone actual custody of 03 months and 08 days and that there is one other case under NDPS Act, 1985 pending against him, in which he has been granted regular bail.

Keeping in view the fact that report of the FSL has still not been received, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail till the receipt of report of the FSL. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail till the receipt of the report of the FSL, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned. Thereafter, on the date of

receipt of report of the FSL, the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned and shall seek regular bail afresh.
