Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh states that in FIR No.330 dated 31.10.2017, under Section 418, 420 IPC and Sections 52-A and 69 of the Copyright Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana (Rural), investigation has been completed by S.P. (Investigation). After investigating the matter, the police has prepared the cancellation report which has been duly approved by SSP, Ludhiana (Rural) and the cancellation report has been submitted to the concerned Court on 10.09.2018.

In view of the aforesaid development, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail the remedy as available under the law.
