The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.45 dated 19.05.2017 registered under Sections 324, 323, 326, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 22.11.2017, the petitioner has already appeared before the Investigating Officer and joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.11.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
