Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondents No.2 to 4 not to submit the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 7 dated 21.02.2015 (P-2), under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station NRI Moga, District Moga.

Petition came up for hearing on 12.10.2018 and the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks adjournment to have instructions as to whether petitioner intends to file contempt petition for non-compliance of order dated 11.09.2018.

List on 20.11.2018.”

Thereafter on 20.11.2018, none appeared for the petitioner and the Court passed the following order:-

“Case called twice since morning but there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 06.12.2018.”
Again on 06.12.2018, none appeared for the petitioner and the
Court passed the following order:-

“On the last date of hearing, case was called twice
but none had appeared. Today also position is the same.
Purely in the interest of justice adjourned to
14.12.2018.”
Today also the position is same as no one has appeared on
behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested to
pursue this matter.

In view of the above factual position, this Court is left with no
alternative except to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.
Dismissed for non-prosecution.
