Petitioner Prabhdeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.141 dated 27.07.2018 under Sections 379-B and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been got registered by complainant-Pankaj Kumar, who stated that on 27.07.2018 at about 8:30 P.M., when he was going to his residence, two youngsters came on a motorcycle and snatched his mobile phone and ran away. The present petitioner has been nominated on the statement of the co-accused.

The present petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and investigation in this case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
