ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.219 dated 12.10.2017, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden fight and the injured has fully recovered from the injuries. The matter has now been compromised between the parties.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 21.11.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court.

The report of JMIC, Jalandhar dated 21.12.2017 has been

received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a sudden fight between the parties and the matter has now been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.219 dated 12.10.2017, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
