In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for the following relief:

“Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the issuance of directions to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners by providing police protection to the petitioners and further directions be issued to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners illegally at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7 and other relatives.

And further directions be issued to respondents or anybody else to not to interfere into the peaceful married life of the petitioners and not to harass the petitioners illegally or forcibly or not to harass them in any manner against their wishes and to their detriment by using force on them or by adopting unlawful means.”

2. Undisputedly, petitioners are from Rajasthan. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that petitioners could not approach jurisdictional Court in the Rajasthan due to threat.

3. If there is a threat in Rajasthan, this Court cannot usurp the jurisdictional Court at Rajasthan.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to

approach jurisdictional Court.
