Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0075 dated 05.05.2006 under Section 356 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala, now Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 03.08.2018 and the offence against him is under Section 356 IPC. He undertakes not to hamper the proceedings and to furnish an affidavit to the effect that he will appear on each and every date before the trial Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the FIR was registered on 05.05.2006 and the petitioner is in custody since 03.08.2018, I deem it appropriate to admit him on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/heavy surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

The petitioner shall give an undertaking to the effect that he shall not be absent from the proceedings.
