The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.77 dated 25.5.2015 under Sections 295-A, 341, 336, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 295, 34 IPC and Sections 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act were added and Sections 295-A, 148, 149 IPC were deleted later on), Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 5.2.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as

well as of Baljinder Singh @ Kala-complainant have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that Baljinder Singh @ Kala-complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been reported by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar that the parties have settled their differences and have reached the compromise without any pressure and that the compromise seems to be genuine.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition stands allowed and FIR No.77 dated 25.5.2015 under Sections 295-A, 341, 336, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 295, 34 IPC and Sections 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act were added and Sections 295-A, 148, 149 IPC were deleted later on), Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
