Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72 dated 18.06.2016 under Sections 457 and 380 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

In the present case, FIR was registered on the complaint of Vijay Kumar Jain regarding theft of 42 batteries of Mark Arvin York Volta Glovalt, 15 Inverteres of Mark Microtex, one Chimney, one Gas Stove of IFB and one Ruler Machine from his showroom. The persons, who stole these articles were not named in the FIR. During investigation, police nominated present petitioner along with Maninder Singh @ Bunty and Jagtar Singh. Jagtar Singh was arrested by the police and from him, four inverters and four batteries were recovered.

The present petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and investigation in this case and some of the stolen articles are still to be

recovered.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
