The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Gurmej Singh in case FIR No.122 dated 26.07.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act'), at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Heard.

It has been submitted that 08 kg of poppy husk has been recovered from the petitioner which falls within the ambit of non-commercial quantity.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
