The petitioner was granted regular bail. Now, non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued as he failed to appear before the trial Court on 10.08.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the non-appearance was on account of inadvertence as the counsel has conveyed wrong date to the petitioner.

The explanation seems to be an excuse only. However, the interest of justice would be better served if the petitioner joins the proceedings rather than remaining absent therefrom.

The petition is disposed of and it is directed that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs. 5,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority and thereafter shall surrender before the trial Court on or before 22.10.2018 and seek regular bail. In case he does so and moves an application for regular bail alongwith receipt as regards deposit of above amount, the learned trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
