The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nishchal Mann, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

It is submitted that the private respondents have already been enjoined by the Civil Court and orders have been passed restraining them from interfering in the possession of the petitioner. It is also submitted that FIR No. 117 dated 24.5.2017 and FIR No. 118 dated 24.5.2017 have been registered against the private respondents at Police Station Pinangwan, Nuh, District Mewat and that no action is being taken thereupon.

Keeping in view the nature of the order being passed, there is no requirement of issuing notice to the private respondents. The petitioner is stated to

have filed representation dated 2.10.2017 (Annexure P-10). The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the said representation and take necessary action thereupon, if deemed necessary in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
