In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:

“1st Petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 and 3 to handover the investigation to any Senior Police Officer in respect of FIR No.88 dated 05.08.2018 U/s 384/457/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Cantt Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) in view of the facts and circumstances of the case.

Further issuance of direction to respondent No.4 to file final report expeditiously in the above said FIR as till date no arrest of the accused persons have been made though roaming freely.”

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Rajinder submitted that petitioner's grievance has been set-right by completing investigation as well as by presenting cancellation report. Copy of the cancellation report has already been furnished to the petitioner.

3. In view of these facts and circumstances, present petition do not survive for consideration. Petitioner is at liberty to question the validity of cancellation report before the appropriate forum.

4. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
