By invoking Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has prayed for quashing of the order dated 20.02.2017, passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.140 dated 24.09.2015, registered under Sections 307, 34 IPC, at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He has further stated that the matter has already been decided and remaining co-accused have been acquitted vide judgment dated 01.08.2017 (Annexure P-4).

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Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, has apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, prayer is allowed and the impugned order dated 20.02.2017, passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender, stands quashed.

Order dated 17.01.2018, passed by this Court is made absolute.
