Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail.

On 22.12.2016, this Court had granted interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and in pursuance to the said orders, petitioner has been joining investigation and has got recovered some of the articles which were said to have been in his possession.

Counsel for the State says that further recovery is to be effected from the petitioner which are household articles.

The said articles are stated to be lying in the godown. The investigating agency should have raided the godown and recovered the articles which are lying there. What has been ordered by this Court is that he should not be arrested. In view of the fact that the petitioner had time and again been joining investigation, as is apparent from the orders passed by this Court, the present petition is allowed.

Order dated 22.12.2016 is confirmed. Petitioner shall, however, continue joining investigation as and when required.
