Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.801 dated 25.06.2018 under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was merely an employee of the company and was working as an Assistant Manager. She is in custody since 13.07.2018 and trial in the case is likely to take a long time.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder has argued that the petitioner was instrumental in getting investment from the poor people in the name of Company. The victims are from the poor strata of society and their hard earned money was invested on

an allurements made by the petitioner for higher returns.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady and she is in custody since 13.07.2018, coupled with the fact that trial in the case is likely to take a long time and the offence is triable by a Magistrate, her culpability in the case is yet to be decided during trial. The petitioner has claimed that she was working as Assistant Manager in the Company, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of her bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not leave the country during the pendency of the trial and will deposit her passport with the trial Court in case she possesses.
