Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.543 dated 25.08.2017, registered at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat, under Sections 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by so many persons alleging that the petitioner alongwith co-accused induced about 200-300 persons for depositing money in the saving accounts, FD, RD, MIS etc. When the complainants did not receive any money even on maturity, they got suspicion and came to know that the Gab

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Rural Development Cooperative Society is fake one and has no existence in the State of Haryana, nor there is any approval to it. When the complainants asked for return of the money, all the accused fled away one by one from the office.

Perusal of the FIR shows that the present petitioner is named in the FIR and serious allegation regarding cheating so many poor persons has been levelled against the accused including the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the above facts and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
