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**JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)**

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 68 dated 18.09.2016 under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner herein has been falsely implicated in this case; he has been in custody since 19.09.2016; and the material witnesses have been examined. He prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner herein.

Mr. V.G. Jauhar, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, as well as learned counsel for the complainant oppose the grant of regular bail while submitting that the allegations are serious in nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the petitioner herein has been in custody since 19.09.2016; the material witnesses have been examined; without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (i) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (ii) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the accused shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
- (iii) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
