This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.171 dated 29.7.2017 under sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 427, 506, 379-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Bawal, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Prosecution version is that the present petitioner along with co-accused namely Raju, Lalit, Ram Bhagat, Hans Raj, Ravi, Baljit, Narender and Happy had come in a white color Swift car on 28.7.2017 at a liquor vend and had assaulted Manoj Kumar, Bijender as also one Bhagwan Singh. Further allegations are that under the threat of beating, Rs.20,000/25,000/- cash was taken away from the cash box of the liquor vend.

Present petitioner was arrested on 13.8.2017. Recovery of a Swift car has been shown against the petitioner.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already stands presented.

It has gone uncontroverted that during the course of trial Manoj Kumar as also Bhagwan Singh, who were stated to have been physically

assaulted in the occurrence, have been examined and they have not supported the prosecution version.

The petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other criminal proceedings.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rewari.

Petition disposed of.
