Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner who was earlier doing the business of consultancy for tourist visa and also used to provide travel tickets to his clients, has stopped the said business. However, the petitioner apprehends threat to his life and liberty at the hand of respondent No.5 at the behest of respondents No.6 to 9. She further states that for the said grievance, petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 25.09.2018 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, District Mohali i.e. respondent No.2.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 5 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Tanvir Joshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case but confining the prayer of the petitioner to protect his life and liberty, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, District Mohali to consider the representation dated 25.09.2018 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioner vis-a-vis the protection of his life and liberty only and to act in accordance with law.

However, in case no such representation has been found/received by respondent No.2, it shall not be incumbent upon the said respondent to act on the said representation.
