This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 436, 427, 148, 149, 120-B IPC, Section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, Section 3 & 4 of Explosive Act, 1908 registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda, vide FIR No.198 dated 25.8.2017.

Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 2.9.2017. He is not named in the FIR. Investigation has been completed and challan presented before the trial court. So, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
