The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.250 dated 17.9.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 306, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Heard.

Raminder Singh committed suicide by consuming poison Sulphas. After his death, his father lodged FIR that the petitioner being the wife of the deceased has illicit relations with one Baljinder Singh.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The petitioner has three children to look after. It is directed that

the investigation in this case be done by a lady police officer.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 15.10.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against her so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
