Petitioners seek the concession of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.119 dated 27.04.2017, registered under Section 379-B/34 IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Briefly noticed, FIR came to be registered on the statement of Kulwant Singh. It was alleged that on 27.04.2017 while the complainant was going on a scooter along with his wife, two unidentified assailants on motorcycle stopped them and gold ear rings of his wife were snatched which were weighing about half *tola*.

CRM-M No.44691 of 2017 (O&M)

Petitioners herein were implicated on the strength of disclosure statements made by them while in custody in relation to another FIR.

Petitioners have faced incarceration since 14.07.2017.

The evidentiary value of the disclosure statements suffered by the petitioners would be a question to be dealt with by the trial Court.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan has been presented and the trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioners are held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.
