The present petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR No. 152, dated 07.10.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 05.02.2018, report dated 13.03.2018 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between the parties without any pressure, threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 152, dated 07.10.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed.
