In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0041 dated 06.08.2016 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act 1985 at Police Station Satnampura District Kapurthala.

2. Petitioner had the benefit of bail. For misusing bail, he was declared as proclaimed offender on 4.7.2018. Thereafter, petitioner surrendered on 16.7.2018. Till date, he is in custody.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh submitted that out of 7 witnesses, two witnesses have been examined.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petitioner-Raj Kumar Thapar alias Raju is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/Trial Court subject to deposit of Rs.50,000/- in cash as a security.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

7. Petition is allowed accordingly.
