Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 15.03.2018 registered under Sections 328, 370, 420, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Uchana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on account of non-appearance on the part of the petitioner on 07.07.2018, her bail was cancelled, bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited and warrants of arrest were issued against her. He further states that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and to face trial with a further undertaking that she will not absent herself during the trial unless exemption is granted.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the warrants of arrest has been issued against the petitioner on account her non-appearance on 07.07.2018 and the case is fixed for 16.11.2018, present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week and undertakes to appear before the trial Court regularly, she shall be admitted on bail subject to her furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The trial Court may impose any other condition which it may deem fit in the circumstances of the case.
