The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.229 dated 07.06.2018, registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram.

It is the prosecution story that on 06.06.2018 between 8-9 p.m., four boys namely Krishan, Pawwa, Rupa and Ankur came and beat the complainant and snatched his motorcycle, phone and Rs.3,000/- cash.

The petitioner was arrested on 19.07.2018. However, nothing pertaining to this case has been recovered from him. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Pawan Kumar is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the

satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
- (d) That he will maintain peace and be of good behaviour.
